Homework policy

Electronic Policy

If students are using a device inappropriately in class, the device will be confiscated. Repeat offenses will be referred to administration and parents will be contacted.

Activities like Kahoot! and Quizizz can be accessed through phone. Other learning activities will use school-provided chromebooks/ computers.

Other Policies

Request to Retest: If a student makes less than an 85 on a quiz/test, they can retake within 3 days of the original test.

Student must fill out a retest form and schedule the retake for before/after school.

Class Tickets: Students will be given 6 tickets for classroom management each grading period. Students can lose tickets for not having materials in class. Students can gain tickets for excellent class work, etc. Unused tickets can be "cashed" in for extra credit at the end of the grading period.
