
Greek and Roman Day Costume Ideas May 11, 2018




Tunic-

- 1. Fold a sheet in half
- 2. Sew up the sides into a tube
- 3. Cut the top so you have rabbit ears to tie at the shoulder
- 4. Add a belt and decorations







Toga-

- 1. Drag left end over left shoulder
- 2. Gather the right end and drape over left shoulder across the front of your body.
- 3. Add a belt
- 4. Tuck the left end under the belt

T-shirt Toga-

- 1. Take a very large men's white t-shirt
- 2. Cut the sleeves off
- 3. Belt at the waist
